Program Description

The Project Early Preschool is an integrated preschool program designed to provide rich experiences that promote a solid foundation of preschool skills for young children ages 3 to 5 years old. Learning is maximized through a developmentally appropriate, multi-sensory, hands on approach to curriculum and skill acquisition, in language based classrooms. The Creative Curriculum is used to facilitate skill building in the area of social-emotional development, physical development, cognitive development, and language development. Activities include storytelling, dramatic play, music & movement, arts & crafts, playground activities (including riding toys), sensory play, block building, teacher made activities, and small manipulatives (legos, tile work, etc.) and cooking activities.

Who is Eligible to Attend?

*Children residing in Foxborough who will turn 3 on or before August 31st.

Classroom/Sessions/Cost

Project Early Preschool offers 2, 3, and 4 half day sessions. Each classroom enrolls up to 15 children (8 lottery and 7 identified as being eligible for special education services). Classrooms are staffed with highly qualified, D.E.S.E. certified, well trained teachers and assistants.

Annual Tuition Cost (subject to change)

\$1300/yr – 2 sessions per week

\$1800/yr – 3 sessions per week

\$2300/yr – 4 sessions per week
